College Plans: I will attend Marquette University and play volleyball as preferred walkon.

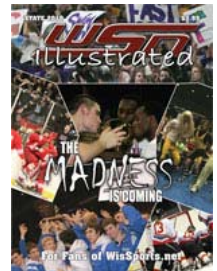
